- 1. Call to order 7:15 PM

The North Lawndale Community Coordinating Council is doing so many good projects! We heard about Soup/Salad for the Soul, \$10 free produce on Mondays, Light of Lawndale, Love Blooms Here, and the Container Plaza. There are outdoor activities and coffee/tea available at the plaza. WB provided them with about 100 kids bikes for their Holiday Giveaway. Their Moving Freely program will kick off on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Reshorna says "yes to everything for the community."

- 4. International Partner Presentation Xail Hernandez, CESTA, El Salvadore Xail's recent trip to our long-standing partner was a great success, and we saw photos of the shop, community rides, and their wonderful staff. Their staff takes time to repair anything. The plywood that we send has been reused for flooring and walls in their building. Xail's enthusiasm for their work is really terrific, and the personal connections she made should be helpful to ensure that we are sending them the bikes, parts and tools that they most need.
- 5. Operations updates
  - a. Storefront

Josh reported that he's still on the lookout for skilled mechanics to help maintain production in this busy time. Parts supply continues to be a challenge due to the pandemic and shipping disruptions. Having interns has been very helpful.

- b. Service Department
  In Xail's absence, Josh added that staff has been coordinating with Sanchez's Bike
  Shop to accommodate customers' timely repairs.
- c. Collections and incoming donations

  Trevor said that the intake quantity of bikes collected is not quite back to 100%,
  but should be better than last year since many community recycling events are
  resuming after a year off.

Anna is heading the effort to develop this, and a focus will be communicating that we want to welcome people back into the shop, but while all are following defined protocols.

f. Building Accessibility

Ed Hanlon is donating his time and skill as an architect to improve our front entrance, the bathrooms, the "Community Hub" (where bikes have been stacked next to Brandon's), and the kitchen. He has obtained donated cabinets and plumbing will be the next design task. Permits will be obtained as may be needed. Ed has long worked with "Designs for Dignity" to assist nonprofits with such work. Thank you, Ed!

- 6. Brandon's & Kitchen Crew Updates
  - a. Brandon's Bike Shop

Anna said that it's nice to have the activity of volunteers back in Brandon's. The goal is to accommodate up to five volunteers at this time.

As mentioned previously, this area will be cleared of stored bikes in order to provide more comfortable space for staff and volunteers.
